## **Position Overview:**

The **Children's Camp Co-ordinator**, will work closely with the Pastor of Mission & Mobilzation (staff) in providing an exceptional summer camp experience for both children and families from CPBC and the surrounding community. For the applicant, this is an opportunity to gain practical ministry experience, to work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support, and to develop spiritually and theologically.

### **Responsibilities:**

The **Children's Camp Co-ordinator** will <u>lead</u> the week of summer Children's Day Camp (July 22-26), and will <u>assist</u> with the community connection initiatives and Sunday CPKids programming.

### CHILDREN'S SUMMER CAMP

The Children's Camp Co-ordinator will lead, alongside the Pastor of Mission & Mobilization and/or Camp Planning Team, in order to do the following:

- Promote and assist families to invite their non-church-going neighbours and friends to Camp
- Generate, plan, lead, and implement a one week Children's Day Camp (July 22-26)
- Oversee camp registration
- Recruit, train and lead volunteers, especially students, to serve at the camp
- Ensure the safety, accessibility, and supervision of children participating in Camp
- Help plan and implement 'Camp Sunday' (July 28) in order to help campers and their families connect into the church community
- Provide leadership and direction for the Community Programs Co-ordinator as he/she assists with Camp

### COMMUNITY CONNECTION INITIATIVES & CPKIDS PROGRAMS

- Assist with the planning and implementation of Community Connection Initiatives that will happen after camp
- Help ensure smooth operation, proper supervision, and a safe environment for Children participating in Community Initiatives
- Support with the CPkids Sunday programs throughout the summer, as requested



# **Qualifications:**

- Committed follower of Jesus Christ authentic lifestyle demonstrating consistent character and spiritual growth
- Ability to work effectively with youth and children, exhibiting creativity, compassion and patience
- Ability to verbally articulate a personal faith and a Christian world view
- Ability to work well in a team environment.
- In full agreement with CPBC's Mission, Vision, Values and Beliefs
- Demonstrates flexibility, humility and a desire to develop in ministry leadership
- Must complete Plan to Protect training (provided) and be willing to apply for a Criminal Record Check
- Be between the ages of 15 and 30 at the start of employment, and be authorized to work in Canada.

### Experience & Education:

Though not strictly required, the ideal candidate...

- has had previous experience serving in church ministry (volunteer or paid)
- Is enrolled in a post-secondary program, and
- Is studying to enter a children's, youth, and/or family support/ministry related field of work

#### Next Steps:

Please note that this role is partially dependent on funding and timelines outside of our control. Clarity around these issues will be communicated to those who proceed forward in the selection process.

• NOTE: Both the start date, and how these hours/weeks are spread out is open to negotiation. We are willing to discuss spreading fewer hrs/wk over more weeks, or vice-versa. The greatest benefit for CP is to start as early as possible, and front-load hours prior to the camp in the last week of July.
